

The Town of Aurora Building Department reminds all residents of the Town and Village Code regarding political signs. In both the Town and Village, political signs are only allowed 30 days prior to an election and must be removed two (2) days after the election. The signs are only permitted on private property (not between the sidewalk and street in the Village).

For the general election, at this time all residents are asked to remove such signs from their property until October 8, 2016. Any general election candidate signs on display at this time are in violation and a letter will be sent noting the same.

For primary elections on September 13, please remove the signs no later than September 15.
