# 1) <u>Building Dept. – request to attend conference</u>:

Patrick Blizniak and William Kramer are requesting to attend the 2016 Niagara Frontier Building Officials Conference on January 25-27, 2016 in Buffalo, NY. This will be put on the November 23, 2016 meeting agenda.

### 2) <u>Civil Service Title Change – C. Musshafen</u>:

Based on the Erie County Civil Service eligibility list, Kathleen Moffat is requesting to change Christopher Musshafen's civil service title from Aquatics Director full-time provisional to Aquatics Director full-time permanent. This will be put on the November 23, 2016 meeting agenda.

### 3) **SSMC Kitchen Fire Suppression**:

The fire suppression system in the kitchen at the Southside Municipal Center needs to be inspected every six months as long as the gas is still hooked up to the stove, ovens, etc. Since the kitchen is not being used, the Board felt that the appliances should be disconnected and the gas turned off.

#### 4) <u>Town Code Review</u>:

The revisions to Chapter 116 – Zoning of the Town Code were reviewed along with the penalties and fines in other chapters of the code that did not meet the requirements to make them violations. The revised code will be forwarded to the Planning Board for their comments. The Town Board will ask them to respond within two months of receipt of the document.
