- o Proof of ownership If title has been held for more than 2 months, it will be in Assessor Records and proof is not needed OR if a there has been a recent closing date, we will need the Deed Indenture and Receipt from County Clerk's Office.
- One set of plans sealed and signed by NYS licensed architect or engineer (Floor, elevations, basement, materials to be incorporated, details of structural, mechanical and electrical work
- o Carbon monoxide alarm installed on any story having a sleeping area and where there is fuelfired appliances or equipment
- o Drainage plan
- o SWPPP/Notice of Intent/Erosion & Sediment control plan (over 1 acre)
- o Energy Audit/Statement AKA REScheck (completed by Architect or Engineer)
- o Truss Sheets if applicable
- o Plan review check list showing details-to be filled out by your Architect or Engineer
- o Soil bearing verification
- o Plot Plan/ survey showing proposed location of dwelling
- o Board of Health approval for septic system, or/
- o Paid sewer/storm sewer receipt from Erie County Sewer/Village Dept of Public Works
- o Paid water receipt from Town or Village Clerk/Erie County Water Authority if applicable
- Name and address of General Contractor
- o Affidavit if application not signed by property owner
- o Worker's Compensation/General Liability/Disability Insurance Certificates

<u>SOLID FUEL BURNING APPLIANCE</u> - permit needed (IE. FIREPLACE, WOOD STOVE, MANUFACTURED FIREPLACE INSERTS, FREESTANDING)
