DOG CENSUS

The Town of Aurora will be conducting a dog census beginning February 2018 through the spring of 2018 in the Village of East Aurora. The census is being conducted to determine the number of dogs harbored in the Village of East Aurora and to ensure that all dogs are licensed. Enumerators (with Town of Aurora photo identification) will contact every resident and business in the Village of East Aurora. New York State Law requires all dogs four months of age and older to be licensed. In addition to the fee an additional \$5.00 fee will be charged for all dogs found to be unlicensed during the census. Proof of rabies vaccination or exemption and spay/neuter certification are required to license a dog. Dog licenses may be obtained at the Aurora Town Clerk's office, Southside Municipal Center 300 Gleed Ave. East Aurora, NY, during regular business hours: Monday through Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm.
