ELECTRONICS RECYCLING ANNOUNCEMENT

A message to Town of Aurora Residents (outside of the Village of East Aurora):

Last week we were informed by our current electronics recycling contractor they will no longer be able to accept cathode ray tube televisions for free. This is due to the overwhelming volume of CRT material waste and lack of Government funding to properly recycle them. Currently there are no other local electronics recycling companies that do not charge a fee for this. Our contractor will be charging twenty cents per pound for CRT electronics, effective immediately.

Because of this change it is no longer cost effective for the Town of Aurora to provide electronics recycling services at this time. Our last electronics pickup for 2014 is the week of October 6th 2014. As of October 11th we will no longer be able to provide electronics recycling pick up or drop off at this time. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.
