Harrison Kelly, Grover Road/Olean Road, thanked the Planning Board for their in-depth review of his rezoning request and asked the Town Board to take into consideration that the West Herr lot across from his property is zoned C2. Mr. Kelly stated that he can appreciate the neighbors' concerns and that he wants to be a good neighbor to abutting properties. Deputy Supervisor Snyder stated that the rezoning would not be specific to Mr. Kelly, but to the property and that a special use permit and site plan would cover the hours of operation, etc.
