UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Supervisor Bach stated that the developer for Aurora Mills Cluster Subdivision submitted additional information that the Board had requested. William Wheeler and Greg Keyser from CRA reviewed the submission. Mr. Wheeler stated that the documents submitted meet the criteria needed for sketch plan review, but SEQR will have to be updated as the project progresses. Councilman Snyder stated he would like more time to review the documents. Councilwoman Jeffe stated she would like to go over this at the next work session. Supervisor Bach stated this would be put on the June 16th work session agenda. Highway Supt. Gunner commented on the dead-end street on the plan, noting he would prefer a turn-around.
