WHEREAS, on March 26, 2019, the Town of Aurora Building Department mailed, via USPS certified/return receipt, a Notice of Unsafe Building to the owner of record, Foison Holdings, LLC, 1960 East Tremont Ave., 5B, Bronx, New York 10462, for property at 2250 Blakeley Road, Town of Aurora, PO East Aurora, New York; SBL #188.01-1-21; and

WHEREAS, said Notice, which was served and posted, which Notice included direction that the property owner is instructed to repair or demolish the building within 30 days from the date of the Notice and gave further notice that on failure to reply, the Town will seek remediation or demolition of the structure; and

WHEREAS, in a memo dated March 19, 2019, the Code Enforcement Officer informed the Town Board of the unsafe conditions of a building at 2250 Blakeley Road and requested a public hearing be set in accordance with Town Code Chapter 65; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board set a public hearing for April 8, 2019 and that said Notice of Public Hearing was posted on March 28, 2019 and published in the East Aurora Advertiser on March 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was held on April 8, 2019 and the Town Board accepts the report of William Kramer, Code Enforcement Officer, of the unsafe conditions of the building at 2250 Blakeley Road.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that in the event that the owner has not responded to the Notice of Unsafe Building in a timely manner, the Town Board of the Town of Aurora authorizes the buildings at 2250 Blakeley Road, Town of Aurora, PO East Aurora, New York, to be demolished and removed by the contractor making the lowest price proposal to the Town; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expense thereof shall be assessed against the Premises as a special ad valorem levy under Town Law Article 15 and a proceeding to collect the expenses of such work shall be instituted.
