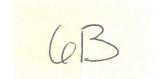

TOWN OF AURORA SENIOR CENTER DIRECTOR'S REPORT MONTH OF March 2020

The mission of the Town of Aurora Senior Center is to help older adults remain healthy and active through participation in recreational pursuits and to provide leadership and advocacy to ensure the availability of leisure and recreational opportunities for seniors.

ADMINISTRATION:

I attended our quarterly director's meeting at the Lancaster Senior Center on March 10th. Our discussions centered on programs but had we known what was coming it may have taken a different outlook.

Our AARP tax preparation at the center ended early with the closure of the center. Many seniors who are on a limited income look to this free service as a help. We hosted training for Eric County Senior Services on a program called a Matter of Balance and the Census. We were preparing to offer assistance in completing the online census forms. The Matter of Balance trains Peer Leaders in preparation for an 8 week class on keeping seniors strong and injury free.

Lastly I want like to commend our staff as they did a fantastic job in the COVID 19 crisis. Our seniors who participate in our nutritional lunch program were switched to the Meals on Wheels program not an easy task in a short period of time. Many of our seniors were not receptive and had to be talked into the temporary switch. The numerous phone calls made to alert seniors to cancellations and identifying solutions for the many situations that arose. They worked politely and calmly during this stressful time.

We are still working with our dietician from Erie County Senior Services, Elizabeth Anderson. We are still getting calls daily for resource information and help navigating the county website. We also get many calls from seniors who are socially isolated and just need a friendly ear. The staff makes wellness calls to check on their health and wellbeing. The thing we are hearing over and over again is how they appreciate the center and our staff. They look forward to when we can resume our activities at the center.

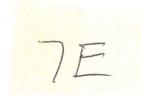
