The Building Department has reviewed your request for an addition to your residence. The request has been denied because it fails to meet the requirements of the Town of Aurora Code for the Residence 1 (R1) zoning district in which it is located. Also of note, the Hubbard Park subdivision was approved and recorded with a typical lot layout of 30' front yard setback, a 10' side yard setback, and a 50' rear yard setback. For this reason, the proposed side yard setback of 16' 7.25"

is allowed as presented.

Section 116-8.1G(1)

Required: Rear yard principal building: a minimum of 50 feet, measured from the wall of the principal building closest to the rear property line.

Requested: 31' rear yard setback

Variance: 19'




