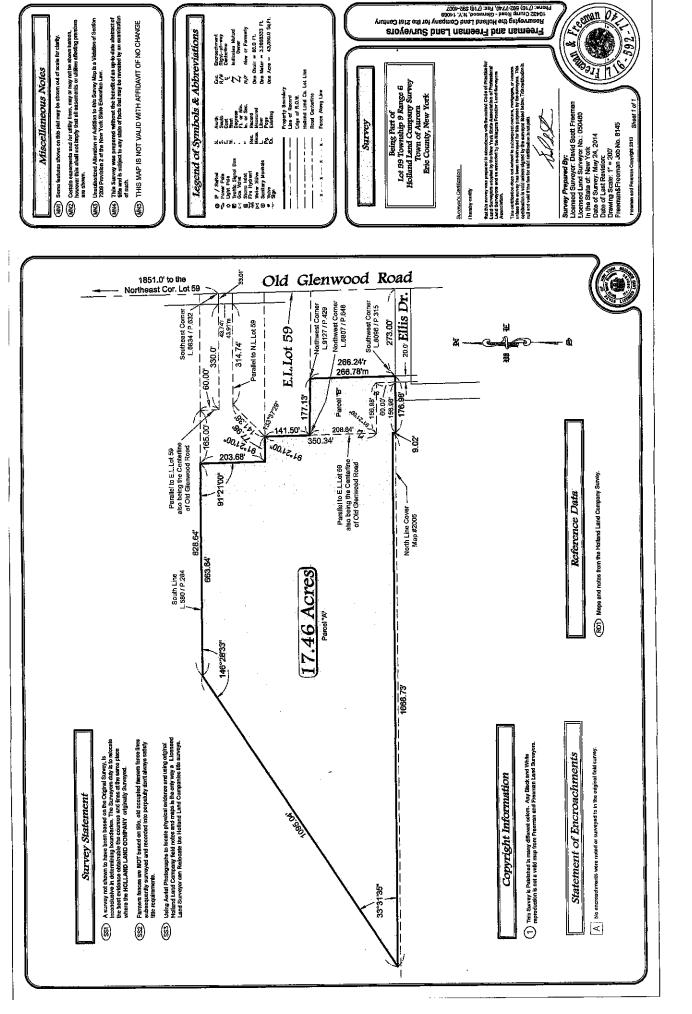

Dear Aurora Town Board:

We have resided at 2021 Blakeley Road for a little over a year. If you are not familiar with this address, it is the farm on the right side on the very sharp corner as you head east on Blakeley Road from Underhill Rd toward Olean Rd (Rt 16). During the past 2 years we have witnessed cars and trucks travelling at very dangerous speeds around the corner. Over this past winter we saw 3 cars hit the guardrail, and saw signs of other accidents at this corner. This part of Blakeley Road has many residences and a restaurant (The Old Orchard). It is also a very busy road used to cut from Center St to Olean Rd. The current speed limit is 45 MPH, and I believe this to be excessive for the sharp turns, steep hill, and home density in this area. Those familiar with the road seem to ignore the suggested 20MPH for the sharp turn, and those unfamiliar with the road seem to miss the signage. There is currently a short guardrail on the corner, but if one were to be traveling too fast and miss the guardrail, they could very easily end up in our living room, as our house is close to the street. It is difficult to pull out of our driveway at times due to the speed in which cars are traveling around the corner. We have farmers who actively farm our land and pull out of our driveway with tractors and hay wagons, and I worry about a bad accident here. I would love to see a decrease from 45MPH to 35MPH on Blakeley Rd between Underhill Rd and Olean Rd and better signage warning of the 90 degree turn in the road.

I kindly ask you to request a TE-9 speed study for Blakeley Rd between Rt 16 and Underhill Rd with a concentration on the speed at which vehicles are traveling around the turn in front of our house. I truly thank you for your anticipated help with this request. If I can be of any assistance, please let me know.

The new Director of Recreation and Aquatics found it necessary to postpone his start date to July 28 due to illness in the family, therefore we will work together for the month of August.

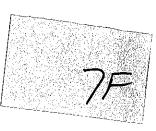
