The Building Department has reviewed your request to construct a detached garage at your ODA lot at 1432 Emery Rd. The request has been denied because it fails to meet the current ODA code requirements for the Town. To alleviate an additional variance request, you have agreed to install the bump out that is required from the ROW to the turnoff of the neighbor's property.

Section 99-31A(2)

Required: The flagpole portion of the lot must have a minimum of 75' of frontage on an existing ROW and maintain a minimum 75' wide right of way retained by the property

owner.

Requested: 2014 approved ODA lot with 60' frontage and width of right of way. Variance: 15'

Required: Side yard setback of 50'

Requested: 20' Variance: 30'

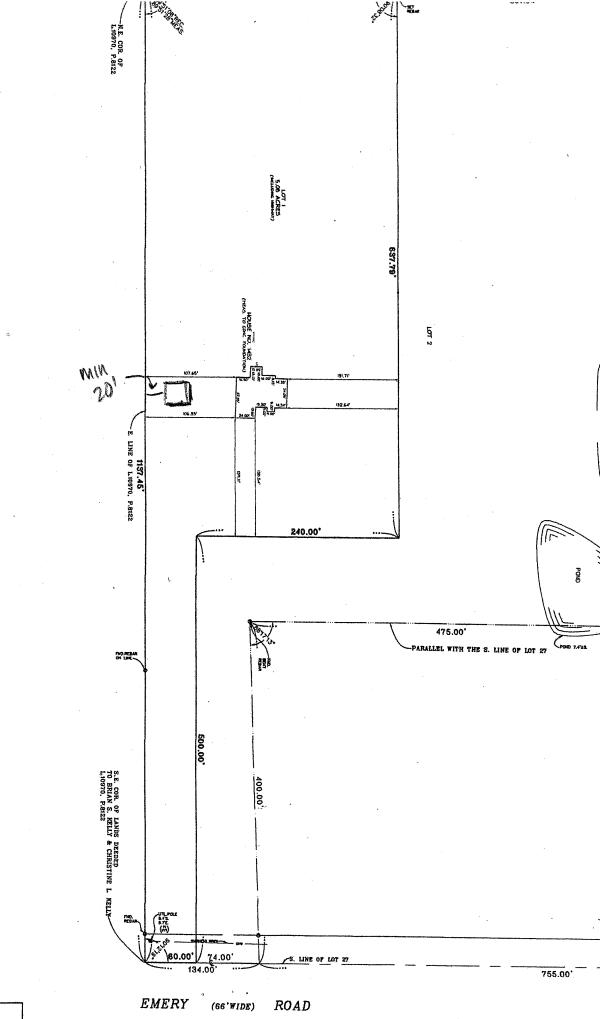
