GENERAL INFORMATION

1. November Event: "Snovember," as the latest record setting storm has been named, brought out the best in both the PD and EAFC in terms of handling the sheer volume of calls to making welfare checks, running medications and assisting highway crews clearing the roads by controlling all the traffic on the road once the travel ban went into effect. Also the cooperation between the PD, EAFC, EAFD, WFFC, SWFC, DPW, Emergency Management, Town Highway, Building Dept. and both levels of town and village gov't. were unprecedented for the first 48-72 hours of the storm, when we were basically by "ourselves." The storm from our standpoint was basically a communications event where 3 PSD's worked around the clock handling numerous 911, administrative calls and thousands of radio transmissions. The following table represents totals from the beginning of the storm (11/17) to the end (11/24) to give you a sample of the volume of calls.

Keep in mind that PSD's fielded all calls from inquiring if the Farmer's Market is open to people calling to report their roof may be collapsing. All told EAFC did an outstanding job of not only fielding the calls but handling them professionally under the circumstances. I also want to mention that the Hampton Inn "comped" a couple rooms at the hotel for our PSD's because they couldn't get home.

- 2. Personnel: K-9 Clip and PO Waldron recently completed their NYS narcotics search certification and are now detailed as a K-9 Unit. In another personnel matter I want to note that during the storm 3 officers were hurt falling on ice/snow while checking stuck vehicles for occupants. Injuries included shoulder, neck and back variety. One officer is currently under the care of a Doctor, however, still working.
- 3. Training: Three officers recently attended a seminar on outlaw motorcycle gangs. In addition the PD will be undergoing their semi-annual firearms training in January. The training will be conducted at an indoor range and paid for by donations that have been collected in our T&A training account. Indoor training affords us the opportunity to "night shoot" and fine tune skills. As a sidebar all officers are annually trained in the use of force during a range day.
- 4. In additional to VB/TB and staff meetings also attended the following:
 - a. Conducted several pistol permit interviews;
 - b. Attended emergency management meetings during the storm as well as sat in on the daily county EOC teleconference briefings. On a side note I think the Vg/Tn collected enough unused "tickets" to earn a trip to Darien Lake Theme Park this summer.
- 5. Misc.: Will begin work on formulating the 2014-2015 budget.
