Reports:

- We had 430 individual program registrations in the month of July
- We generated \$13,077 in July sales
- Credit card purchases totaled 59% (78% on-line, 22% office)
 - 2014 to 2015 comparison:
 - Total sales from 1/1/14 7/31/14 \$184,886
 - Total sales from 1/1/15 7/31/15 \$167,784

The wet and cool summer has taken a toll on the pool revenue this season. Pool memberships are down compared to 2014. However, our daily receipts are about \$1,000 higher than last year at this time.

Many of our summer programs are wrapping up. Our staff handled the cool and wet weather well. A big thank you goes out to the Boys and Girls Club for allowing us to use their facilities.

EAST's coaching staff will be traveling to Cleveland, OH for the ASCA World Clinic in early September. We will be there along with some of the world's best coaches. The Niagara Local Swim Committee is providing financial assistance along with EAST's fundraising efforts to finance our travel.
